## THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINY BY-LAW NUMBER 12-010

Being a By-law to amend Sign By-law Number 02-073.

WHEREAS Section 8, of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, as amended, provides that powers of a municipality under this Act or any other Act shall be interpreted broadly so as to confer broad authority on municipalities to govern its affairs as it considers appropriate and to enhance the municipality's ability to respond to municipal issues;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 9, of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, powers and privileges of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act;

**AND WHEREAS** Section 11 of The Municipal Act, 2001, S.O., c.25, as amended, provides that a lower-tier municipality may enact by-laws respecting matters within the spheres of jurisdiction set out therein;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Tiny hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. That By-law Number 02-073, Section 1, Definitions, is hereby amended with the inclusion of the following new section:
  - 1.4 "Temporary Sign" shall mean a sign not permanently attached to the ground or other permanent structure and is used for events such as a Garden Tour or Art Show."
- 2. That By-law Number 02-073, Section 2, Regulations, is hereby amended with the inclusion of the following new sections:
  - 2.3.1 The Chief Municipal Law Enforcement Officer is authorized to grant or cancel permission for the placement of Temporary Signs.
  - 2.3.2 A Temporary Sign shall not exceed 60cm X 60cm in size.
  - 2.3.3 Not more that twenty five (25) Temporary Signs shall be permitted for any event.
  - 2.3.4 Temporary Signs may be placed for a period of thirty (30) days prior to the event to not more than five (5) days after the event at which time the signs shall have been removed.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME THIS 30 DAY OF JANUARY 2012.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 30 DAY OF JANUARY

2012.
