THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINY

BY-LAW NUMBER 12-059

Being a By-law to amend Sign By-law 02-073 as amended by By-law 09-052.

WHEREAS By-law 02-073, passed the 30th day of September 2002 regulates signs within the Township of Tiny;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said By-law with regards to the penalty provisions currently in place;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Tiny hereby enacts as follows:

- 1. **That** By-law Number 02-073, Section 3.7., PENALTY:, is deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:
 - 3.7 Every person who contravenes any of the provision of this By-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation, who knowingly concurs in the contravention by the Corporation, is guilty of an offence under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
 - 3.8 Every person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation, who knowingly concurs in the contraventions by the corporation, is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty where the minimum fine shall not be less than \$500 and the maximum shall not exceed \$100,000 exclusive of costs under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
 - 3.9 For the purpose of continuous offences, every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of a by-law of the Corporation is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000, exclusive of costs under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
 - 3.9.1 Despite section 3.9 and the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the total of all daily fines for the offence is not limited to \$100,000.
 - 3.10 For the purpose of multiple offences, every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of a by-law of the Corporation is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000, exclusive of costs under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
 - 3.10.1 Despite section 3.10 and the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the total of all daily fines for the offence is not limited to \$100,000.

 That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.
