THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF TINY

BY-LAW NUMBER 14-042

Being a By-law to amend Parks By-law 03-053 regarding the Tiny Trail.

WHEREAS By-law 03-053, passed the 9th day of June 2003 regulates the activities on the linear park known as the "Tiny Trail" within the Township of Tiny;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed necessary to amend the said By-law with regards to the permitted uses currently in place;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for The Corporation of the Township of Tiny hereby enacts as follows:

1. **That** By-law Number 03-053, Section 2., PERMITTED USES:, be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

2. PERMITTED AND PROHIBITED USES:

- 2.1 Permitted uses on the Tiny Trail include pedestrian, cyclist, snowmobile and equestrian use. The use of an ATV is permitted until December 31st, 2014.
- 2.2 Dirt Bikes and Motor Vehicles are prohibited on the Tiny Trail. The use of an ATV is prohibited effective January 1st, 2015.
- 2. **That** By-law Number 03-053, be amended by deleting Sections 5, 6, and 7 in their entirety.
- 3. That By-law Number 03-053, Section 12., PENALTY:, be deleted in its entirety and replaced with the following:

12. PENALTY:

- 12.1 Every person who contravenes any of the provision of this By-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation, who knowingly concurs in the contravention by the Corporation, is guilty of an offence under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
- 12.2 Every person who contravenes the provisions of this by-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation, who knowingly concurs in the contraventions by the corporation, is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty where the minimum fine shall not be less than \$100 and the maximum shall not exceed \$100,000 exclusive of costs under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
- 12.3 For the purpose of continuous offences, every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of a by-law of the Corporation is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000, exclusive of costs under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.

- 12.3.1 Despite Section 12.3 and the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the total of all daily fines for the offence is not limited to \$100,000.
- 12.4 For the purpose of multiple offences, every person who contravenes any provision of this by-law and every Director or Officer of a Corporation who knowingly concurs in the contravention of a by-law of the Corporation is guilty of an offence and liable on conviction to a penalty not exceeding \$10,000, exclusive of costs under the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended.
 - 12.4.1 Despite section 12.4 and the provisions of the Municipal Act, 2001, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, the total of all daily fines for the offence is not limited to \$100,000.
- 4. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on the date of passing.

READ A FIRST AND SECOND TIME THIS 30th DAY OF JUNE 2014.

READ A THIRD TIME AND FINALLY PASSED THIS 30TH DAY OF JUNE 2014.
