


A site diagram identifies buildings, structures and other features in relation to a property.

A site diagram is required to be submitted with every short term rental accommodation license application per Township By-law 22-017.

The following information must be shown on a site diagram:

- Title and scale
- Street name(s)
- North arrow
- Property lines with dimensions
- All existing buildings and structures including the location of the sewage system and well (if applicable)
- The use of all existing buildings and structures (i.e. house, garage, shed, deck, etc.)
- Parking area and number of parking spaces with dimensions
- The type of surface of the parking area. It is noted that the parking area shall consist of a hard-surfaced driveway (gravel, paved, concrete, interlock or similar hard surface). Vehicles may only park in the parking area.



## NOTES:

- 1. Do not submit this sample site diagram as part of any short term rental accommodation license application.
- 2. The site diagram must match the floor plan submitted.
- 3. The site diagram must be provided to scale.
- 4. The minimum required parking space size is 3 metres (10 feet) by 6 metres (20 feet).
