# Township reminds residents that Interim Control By-law is in effect for shoreline in Tiny

**Date:** October 13, 2023

The Township of Tiny is reminding residents that there is an Interim Control By-law in place to prohibit the erection of any structure, fence or sign through the duration of this by-law. This includes, but is not limited to, boathouses, retaining walls, patios, landscaping, decks, fences, walls, or shoreline alteration that are in proximity to the 178-metre contour elevation of the Georgian Bay Shoreline.

Council passed By-law 23-044 on May 29, 2023, and amending By-law 23-048 on June 7, 2023, pursuant to Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13 as amended.

The Interim Control By-law will be in effect for a period of one (1) year from the date of passing, lapsing May 29th, 2024, but may be extended by Council for an additional one-year period in accordance with Section 38 of the *Planning Act*, or repealed by Council at an earlier date.

The purpose of the By-law is to provide the Township with the opportunity to undertake a study to review its land use planning policies pertaining to retaining walls, fences, landscaping, and structures in proximity to the 178-metre contour elevation of the Georgian Bay Shoreline; and to ensure that any retaining walls, fences, landscaping and structures are appropriately sited and regulated once the study has been completed.

On October 11, 2023, Public Works Report PWR-044-23 was presented to members of Council which outlined the Dynamic Beach Management Strategy Cost Estimate. The estimate was provided to Council for consideration on choosing a method that will help to develop Tiny's Dynamic Beach Management Strategy. The development of the strategy is thanks to the Interim Control By-law in effect.






