(Tiny, Ontario) Over the period of June 28 to July 1, Township of Tiny By-law Officers were on full patrol responding to calls ranging from dog and beach concerns, fireworks, and fires.

Beach Reminders regarding Dogs

A reminder to the community that as per <u>By-law #02-115</u>, as amended, dogs are prohibited on Balm Beach between June 1 and September 30. Additionally, a reminder that as per <u>By-law #19-040</u> dogs are prohibited on Cawaja Beach, from 10:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., between June 15 and September 15.

Roadside Debris

Please be reminded that roadside debris (i.e. broken chairs, old furniture and tables, old BBQ, scrap metal, etc.) is not permitted on the road allowance as there is <u>no free pickup</u>. Items that are left on the roadside will be issued a Yellow Sticker requiring their removal within 72 hours. Items remaining after 72 hours may be picked up by Township of Tiny Staff, disposed of and a Non-Compliant Waste Service Fee of \$180 will be applied.







Temporary Beach Encroachments

Residents and visitors are reminded that personal items/private property cannot be left unattended or on municipally owned property overnight. Personal property also cannot be stored on municipal property. Examples of personal items include but are not limited to: chairs, tables, watercraft, boats and their launches/docks/lifts, decks/platforms, fire pits, umbrellas and tents, kayaks, and paddleboards.

Personal items left on municipal property will be labelled with a yellow warning tag and must be removed within seven calendar days. Where a tagged item is not removed within seven calendar days, the municipality will remove the items and store them at a municipal facility to allow property owners to recover their items. If the items at the municipal facility are not claimed by the owner within 30 days, the items will be disposed of.
